Neighbor, friend, and friendless;

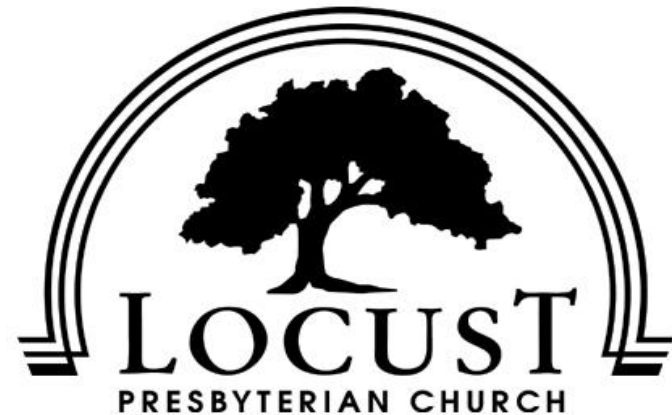
